(I) THE MARVELOUS WORKS OF GOD

1. They reveal the Nature of God
2. They teach vital truths about the Person of God

(II) THE COVENANTS OF GOD

1. What is a Covenant?

- a) It may be compared to a treaty between God and man
- b) It describes the following:-
 - i) God's commitment to His word contained in the covenant
 - ii) His expectations concerning His covenant-people
 - iii) His laws
 - iv) His promises
 - v) His admonition should there be a deliberate attempt to break the Covenants

2. The Covenant with Abraham

- a) This is mind in **Psalm 105**
- b) An important observation

*“He remembers His covenant forever,
The word which He commanded, for a thousand generations.” Psalm 105:8a*

3. God's regard for His covenants reveals much about Himself

- a) He is the LORD God
- b) He will remember His covenant
- c) His covenant is His Word
- d) He will be true to His word... forever

(The idea behind the phrase “a thousand generations”)
