 - a) Great things are meant for us to study...to see how amazing they are
 - b) Especially the great works of God...much for us to learn from and to appreciate
- 2. We should have pleasure in them
 - a) Great pleasure in experiencing these great works
 - b) Great pleasure in understanding these great works
 - c) Great pleasure in knowing the God of these great works

1. Fulfilled based on the word of God

- a) Sure (**Psalm 111:7**)

- d) Uprightness (Psalm 111:8)

2. Fulfilled based on the covenant of God

a) The promise of redemption was fulfilled

"He has sent redemption to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name." **Psalm 111:9**

- i) Redemption from Egypt
- ii) As commanded by His covenant
- b) The promise of a heritage was fulfilled

"He has given food to those who fear Him; He will ever be mindful of His covenant. He has declared to His people the power of His works, in giving them the heritage of the nations." **Psalm 111:5, 6**

- i) Sustaining Israel through the wilderness
- ii) Through His power, He fulfilled the promise of the heritage of the promise land

a) Whole heartedly

b) Corporately

"In the assembly of the upright and in the congregation." **Psalm 111:1**

c) Always

"His praise endures forever." Psalm 111:10
