 - a) Because he was personally saved through faith in the gospel Acts 9
 - i) His experience of salvation left an indelible impression on his soul
 - ii) He made constant reference to his salvation (Acts 22:1-21; 26:1-24; 1 Timothy 1:12-17)
 - b) Because he had a calling from God to preach and defend the gospel

i) A holy calling 2 Timothy 1:9

ii) An appointment from God to teach/ preach 2 Timothy 1:11;

iii) An appointment to defend the Gospel Philippians 1: 17

iv) As a pattern for others 1 Timothy 1:16

- c) Because he believed in the power of the message of the cross 1 Corinthians 1:18
