- b) Archers bitterly grieved him (reference to his brothers) (Genesis 49:23)

c) His bow remained in strength/ the arms of his hands were made strong by the mighty God of Jacob, the Shepherd, the Stone of Israel (**Genesis 49:24**)

- d) Blessings from the Almighty God (Genesis 49:25)
- e) Blessings excelled that of ancestors (Genesis 49:26a)
- f) These blessings will be like a crown on Joseph's head (Genesis 49:26c)

6. Benjamin (Genesis 49:27)

- a) A ravenous wolf
- b) He will devour the prey
- c) He will divide the spoil

Genesis 49:28

- 1. Some prophetic words were ominous
- 2. Therein is hope- that they will take heed and turn away from sin
- 3. Blessings are contingent upon obedience
