# 2. Significance of this brief mention

- a) Simeon and Levi
  - i) Their background was far from good (Genesis 34)
  - ii) Spoken of poorly by Jacob on his death bed (**Genesis 49:5-7**)
- b) Yet in the mercies of God they were now poised to play a significant role in the nation of Israel
  - i) Moses would become an outstanding leader
  - ii) Aaron would become high priests
  - iii) His sons would become priests
  - iv) The other sons of Levi would become Levites
- c) The Levites
  - i) Gershon
  - ii) Kohath
  - iii) Merari
