- 3. They assisted the priests in maintaining the service of the Tabernacle/Temple

- 2. Praise to God as King (Israel) Psalm 45
- 3. Praise to God as King (The earth) Psalm 47

PRAYING TO GOD AS KING Psalm 44

- 1. Appreciation of the Role of the King in establishing Israel as a kingdom Psalm 44:1-8
 - a) Drove out the inhabitants of Canaan
 - b) Planted Israel in Canaan
 - c) Glorying in the King
- 2. Approaching the King with the problems facing the nation of Israel Psalm 44:9-16
 - a) The enemies have the upper hand
 - b) Israel is defeated and scorned by the enemies
 - c) The nation is in danger of being destroyed
- 3. Appealing to the King for justice Psalm 44:17-22
 - a) Pleading innocence
 - b) Not guilty of playing false with God's covenant
 - c) Not guilty of departing from God
 - d) Not guilty of forgetting God's name
- 4. Appealing to God to arise and to come to the rescue of His people Psalm 44:23-26
 - a) Desperate plea for immediate help
 - b) Pleading the mercies of God
