1. Lovingly Adhering to the word of God

"Therefore, you shall love the Lord your God and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments and His commandments always . Know today..." **Deuteronomy 11:1-2**

2. Earnestly Increasing our Service to God

"And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the Lord your God and serve Him with all your heart and all your soul..." Deuteronomy 11:13
