**2. Special Reasons for this call to ascribe greatness to God**

- a) Because of the problem of perversity (**Deuteronomy 32:5**)
- b) Because of the problem of foolishness (**Deuteronomy 32:6, 28**)
- c) Because of the danger of forgetting God (**Deuteronomy 32:18**)
- d) Because of the danger of incurring God's wrath (**Deuteronomy 32:19-27**)
