- 1. Faith in God
 - a) As the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 1:3)
 - b) As the Father of mercies (2 Corinthians 1:3)
 - c) As the God of all comfort (2 Corinthians 1:3)
- 2. Faith in God's Comfort
 - a) He personally comforts us (2 Corinthians 1:4)
 - b) He comes alongside (His Presence) (**Psalm 68:8**)
