- "Let Me go, for the day breaks."
- 4. Jacob's reply

"I will not let You go unless You bless me."

Genesis 32:27-29

- 1. The Man's question
- "What is your name?"
- 2. The simple reply
- "Jacob"
- 3. The commendation of Jacob
- a) With a name change

From Jacob to Israel

b) He had struggled

- i) With men
- ii) With God
- c) He had prevailed
- 4. An innocent question

"Tell me Your name, I pray."

5. A profound reply

"Why is it you ask about My name?"

- 6. The blessing of Jacob
- a) No name was revealed
- b) But a blessing was pronounced upon Jacob
