## **UNDERSTANDING THE MINISTRY OF THE HIGH PRIEST**

1. Things pertaining to God Hebrews 5:1

- a) Offering gifts
- b) Offering sacrifices
- 2. Things pertaining to men Hebrews 5:2
  - a) Compassion for the ignorant
  - b) Compassion for those who go astray
- 3. Understanding human frailty Hebrews 5:3
  - a) He is subjected to the same human weaknesses
  - b) He has to make sacrifices for his own sins
- 4. Appreciating this holy office Hebrews 5:4
  - a) It is an honourable office
  - b) He cannot put this honour on himself
  - c) He has to have a calling from God

### THE LORD JESUS CHRIST AS OUR GREAT HIGH PRIEST

1. He did not appoint Himself to the office of being the Great High Priest Hebrews 5:5

- 2. God was the One who called Him
  - a) God had destined Him for this Office Hebrews 5:5
  - b) He was first made Son
    - i) Son of God (Eternal)
    - ii) Son of Man (with reference to His physical life)
  - c) He was meant to be Priest Hebrews 5:6
    - i) Priest forever
    - ii) After the order of Melchizedek

### **HIS EARTHLY MINISTRY**

- 1. His ministry of prayer Hebrews 5:7
  - a) Prayers and supplications
  - b) Vehement cries and tears
- 2. God heard His prayers Hebrews 5:7
  - a) He was heard
  - b) He had godly fear
- 3. Lessons learned Hebrews 5:8
  - a) Learning obedience
  - b) Learning through suffering
- 4. Perfected Hebrews 5:9
  - a) Perfected
  - b) Became author of eternal salvation
- 5. Approved by God Hebrews 5:10
  - a) Called by God as "High Priest"
  - b) Order of Melchizedek
- 6. Hard to comprehend Hebrews 5:11
  - a) Because the topic is complex
  - b) Because of the problem of being dull of hearing
