 - b) He fought the devil and overcame him for us Hebrews 2:14-15
 - i) He dared to fight for us
 - ii) He was willing to suffer for us
 - iii) He was willing to die for us
- 3. The blessings of being "brethren of the Lord"
 - a) He will be our merciful and faithful High Priest
 - b) He has made propitiation for our sins
 - c) He is able to give to all who are tempted the aid they need Hebrews 2:17-18
