Theme: The Glorious Example of how Christ Jesus understood His Purpose of coming to earth

1. The Incarnation (John 1:14; Philippians 2:5-11)

Therefore, when He came into the world, He said, Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me,

In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Hebrews 10:5-6

- a) Understanding what God does not delight in
 - i) Sacrifices
 - ii) Offerings
- b) Understanding God's purpose in giving to Jesus a human body
 - i) Though He was God
 - ii) He took on flesh

2. The Place of the Scriptures and the will of God

Then I said, "Behold, I have come- in the volume of the book it is written of Me- to do Your will."

Hebrews 10:7

- a) Reference is made to the Scriptures
- b) The Scriptures reveal the will of God
- c) The compliance of Jesus to do the will of God

3. Fulfilling the will of God

Then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Hebrews 10:9-10

- a) Through fulfilling God's will
 - i) The first covenant is taken away
 - ii) The second covenant is established
- b) In God's will

We stand sanctified forever through the offering of the body of Christ

4. The witness of the Holy Spirit

But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before... Hebrews 10:15

- a) He bears witness that we are the children of God Romans 8:16
- b) He is our Seal Ephesians 1:13
- c) He is our guarantee Ephesians 1:14
