I really liked the Sunday school atmosphere. Going to Sunday school was something that I looked forward to every week because of the many Bible stories and the songs I learned. I never knew that it was much more than fun until an older person

named Ammachí amma who shared about the grace and the mercies of God with me. I was deeply moved by what she shared with me. My heart yearned to believe in this Great and wonderful God. That moment was special to me.

I then began to attend the Sunday worship services and the Bible study. I saw many uncles and aunties serving in various areas. I too wanted to do something for the Lord. I began to help in some areas in the church. I saw the Pastoral team from Singapore coming over to India to preach the Lord's word. They stood for long hours to teach and preach about God. I asked myself "How come they could stand for so many hours to teach about God and not about themselves?" I was inspired by the way they served the Lord. I saw a selfless and fully dedicated life for the Lord in them. I too wanted to serve the Lord like them.

After finishing my Engineering studies, my heart wanted and desired to serve the Lord. After two and a half years, I resigned from my job and committed myself to serve the Lord as a full time servant. Three years of Bible school in Coimbatore gave me a basic understanding about God and theological knowledge. But I didn't understand that I needed more than basic knowledge to serve effectively. Then Pastor graciously offered me an opportunity to be trained for the Pastoral ministry. Three years of pastoral training over in Bethany IPC changed my life significantly. For me, those three years provided a life changing experience. Serving God involved more than just knowledge. It involved the way we lived. Studying the Lord's word was deep and profound. I had to unlearn many misconceptions and get them right with the teaching of the Lord's word by the Pastors. The love and the friendship extended by the people at Bethany is what I respect and treasure much in my life.




