#### THE PLACE OF THE SCRIPTURES

- 1. They needed to be more familiar with the Scriptures

- 3. The Lord Jesus sought to give them deep insights into the Holy Scriptures

On the day Jesus rose from the dead His disciples were most perturbed when they came to His tomb. They found it empty! They could not comprehend this at all. This comment was made by one of the disciples who ran to the empty tomb.

For as yet they did not know the Scripture, That He must rise again from the dead.

John 20:9

- 1. Faith in the Lord
- 2. Fullness of confidence and joy

# TESTIMONY OF CAMILLE GEORGE

#### A Refined Focus to Serve God

The desire to serve the Lord was planted in my heart in 2010 while I was in University. Even though the desire continued to remain in my heart over the years, I had little focus and too many of my own ideas, and these were things that God had to teach me in my life over the past five years. One verse that Pastor shared with me during that season in my life was Psalm 27:4,

\*One thing I have desired of the Lord,
That will I seek:
That I may dwell in the house of the Lord
All the days of my life,
To behold the beauty of the Lord,
And to inquire in His temple."

And so I made prayers to the Lord asking Him to help me refine and focus my desire on Him. And amazingly, in God's grace, this is what He did.

#### Choosing to walk with God as a priority

As an undergraduate, I thought that in order to succeed in life and a job, I had to prioritize getting good grades. I was convinced I was a failure when I struggled with passing exams in University.

But Pastor encouraged me to follow through with what I had started, and it was through my struggles, that the Lord taught me about how walking the journey with Him was so much more important than the results that I would eventually receive on a piece of paper.

#### **Choosing Bethany**

Another test of my heart was when I was given the opportunity to stay in New York City for a month in July 2014.

During my stay there, I was drawn to the life that so many of my friends had. They were 'globetrotters' with the freedom to move wherever they wanted to. This way of life began to excite and sway my heart, and I found myself weighing the reasons for finding such a life by moving overseas against remaining in Singapore. I knew that I had to deal with these feelings in my heart.

In the month after I returned from New York, Bethany was gearing up towards anniversary celebrations. It was this special time that reminded me again how it has been here in Bethany that I have learnt so much, received so much from the Lord, and experienced deep love.

The Lord helped me see that these things weighed and mattered much more than the fun and excitement of being a 'globetrotter'. Thus, during the 40+1 anniversary, I made a personal and special commitment to the Lord that Bethany was where I wanted to stay to find and serve Him.

That same year, even though I had to stay another month in Tokyo, there was no longer any tussle in my heart, and I was sure that Bethany was where I wanted to be.

#### **Convictions**

Today, I would like to seek your permission to serve the Lord in Bethany because of deep convictions that I have within my heart. I would like to share three of them with you.

For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

From Hebrews 9:13-14, I am deeply impacted that this life I live is one that was paid for by the precious and pure blood of my Saviour.

Secondly, I recognize that there must be a reason that I have been cleansed and removed from my past life. In verse 14, I understand that I ought to use this life to serve the living God.

But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

Thirdly, as it says in 1 Corinthians 15:10, I have experienced much of God's grace in my life from Him and through the many people around me in Bethany. As I see the needs of people and ministry arise, I cannot help but want to learn to labour for the Lord and for the people in Bethany as a response to this grace poured into my life.
