## WHAT PEOPLE WILL DO WHEN THEY FEAR JUDGMENT

Many are the things people will do when they do not want to think about the Judgment of God.

#### 1. Denial

- (a) Many deny that there will be judgment
- (b) Some go further and deny that there is even a God
- (c) Some others will block out any thought about judgment

#### 2. Rejection

- (a) Many reject the concept of Judgment
- (b) Some think that if they reject Judgment, then it will not come to pass

#### 3. Defiance

- (a) Some defy the idea of Judgment
- (b) Some others sin even more as an expression of defiance

#### 4. Resignation

- (a) Some feel that there is no hope
- (b) They resign themselves to whatever is their fate

#### WHAT JESUS OFFERS

There is a better approach and solution to the problem of Judgment. Let us consider what Jesus taught: -

Most assuredly, I say to you,
He who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me
Has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment,
But has passed from death into life. John 5:24

- 1. If we were to face Judgment from God
  - (a) We will come under condemnation
  - (b) The sentence will be spiritual death!
- 2. If we were to have faith
  - (a) In God who sent Jesus
  - (b) In Jesus who came to deliver us from judgment
- 3. The wonderful results: -
  - (a) We will have everlasting life
  - (b) We will not come under Judgment from God
  - (c) We have been passed from death to life

#### **RECEIVING JESUS**

Let us respond appropriately to the promise of the Lord Jesus Christ!

- 1. We have nothing to lose
- 2. We have everything to gain
- 3. We can have eternal life through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ
  - (a) Faith in Jesus as the Messiah sent from God

  - (c) Faith in Jesus and His promise of eternal life

### THE PROMISE OF LIFE JESUS OFFERED

The promise of Life by the Lord Jesus was not well understood by many. The following are observations we may note from a reading of the Gospels.

- 1. The multitudes
  - a) They sought Jesus only in the hope of having their physical needs met
  - b) Those in need spared no effort to seek Jesus out
  - c) Once their needs were met they did not pursue further
- 2. The detractors
  - a) The religious leaders of the day
  - b) The secular Roman rulers
  - c) These were not neutral in their response to the teachings of Jesus
    - i) They ignored
    - ii) They tolerated
    - iii) They opposed strongly

### A CLOSER LOOK AT THE LIFE JESUS PROMISED

It is wise to look more closely at the life the Lord Jesus offered.

- 1. A life forgiven of sin
- 2. A life freed from the tyranny of demons
- 3. A life of abundance

# THE EXAMPLE OF THOSE WHO FOLLOWED JESUS AS DISCIPLES

Jesus called people to follow Him so that they might learn more about this promise of Life. These were called Disciples of Christ! They were prepared to leave everything just to pursue this life Jesus offered.
