THE SAD REALITY OF REJECTION

The sad reality is that there will be people who will reject the Gospel no matter how carefully it may be presented. The Gospel of John gives us some insight as to why some people reject the Lord Jesus Christ.

And this is the condemnation, That the light has come into the world, And men loved darkness rather than light, Because their deeds were evil.

For everyone practising evil hates the light And does not come to the light, Lest his deeds should be exposed.

But he who does the truth comes to the light,
That his deeds may be clearly seen,
That they have been done in God.

John 3:19-21

- 1. Men loved darkness rather than light
