A DECLARATION OF FAITH IN GOD

David expressed his faith in God by making some very significant statements.

1. O God, in You I put my trust	Psalm 16:1
2. You are my Lord	Psalm 16:2
3. You are the portion of my inheritance and my lot	Psalm 16:5
4. I have set the LORD always before me	Psalm 16:8
5. He is at my right hand	Psalm 16:8

HOW DID HE COME TO HAVE SUCH A FAITH IN GOD?

This is an important line of inquiry. Let us ponder how David cultivated his faith in the Lord.

- 1. Through prayer
 - a) David maintained an active prayer life
 - b) He turned to the Lord often
 - c) Often he would pray, "Preserve me, O God, for in You I have put my trust." Psalm 16:1
- 2. Through choosing the Lord

 - a) David saw the Lord as His Teacher
 - b) He noted how the Lord instructed him

'I will bless the LORD who has given me counsel; My heart also instructs me in the night seasons." Psalm 16:7
