WHY WOULD GOD HEAR AND ANSWER OUR PRAYERS?

Let us ponder what the Psalmist David wrote in Psalm 4 to figure out the answer to this question.

- 1. Because of who God is
 - a) He is our God
 - b) He is a God of righteousness
 - c) He is the God who imputes righteousness to us
- 2. Because of His merciful nature
 - a) He is abundant in mercy
 - b) He will hear and answer because He is our God of great mercy
- 3. Because of how God has heard and answered prayer in the past
 - a) He has granted relief in times of distress
 - b) He will yet hear and answer prayers

UNDERSTANDING WHAT GOD EXPECTS OF US

Does God expect us to do our part before He hears and answers prayer? The answer is "Yes."

1. God has set apart those who are godly
