1. The Basis of our being called "brethren"	Hebrews 2:12
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- a) It is the Lord Jesus who calls believers "brethren" Hebrews 2:11
- b) He sanctifies
- c) We are sanctified
- d) He is not ashamed to call us His "brethren" Hebrews 2:11
- 2. The deeply moving Example of Jesus identifying with us
  - a) He donned "flesh and blood" Hebrews 2:14
  - b) Because we are flesh and blood
  - c) He fought the devil on our behalf as our Brother-in-arms
