The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 18:1-2

#### 1. I will love You, O LORD

- a) This is a clear and open statement of love for God
- b) The underlying foundation is that of faith and trust in Him

2. Reasons why we speak of love for the Lord

a) My strength

- i) David found strength from God time and time again
- ii) Have you also found strength from God in time of need? Share how you found strength from the Lord

b) My rock and fortress

- i) David found refuge in God
- ii) There were times when he was in danger; gratefully he turned to God
- iii) There are many out there who wish they can find refuge in God too

- c) My deliverer, My God
  - i) David discovered the Lord as his deliverer on many occasions
  - ii) The LORD was his God in the most personal manner
  - iii) So many do not have a personal faith in God; they too can find God as their Deliverer

d) My shield and the horn of my salvation

- i) The Lord is a wonderfully great Shield
- ii) The salvation that He gives is full and complete
