THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THESE REPEATED PHRASES

What is the significance of these repeated phrases? Let us ponder the following thoughts: -

- 1. To highlight the special act of God in choosing Israel to be His servant
- (a) To be chosen is an astounding truth
- (b) This thought was repeated so that it would be embedded in the heart and mind
- 2. To give encouragement
- (a) To allay anxieties of life
- (b) To dispel feelings of fear and dismay amidst hardship
- (c) To bring joy to the heart
- 3. To reaffirm
- (a) God's relationship with His people was firm
- (b) He would not forsake His people
- (c) He would be there to strengthen and to bless

- (c) To worship the Lord

1. This statement was made by the Lord Jesus Christ after He told the parable of The Workers in the Vineyard.

2. The storyline

- (a) A vineyard owner went out to hire labourers
- (b) The first group discussed with the owner how much they would be paid at the end of the day
- (c) Throughout the day, the owner would notice that some labourers had not been hired
- (d) He went on to hire more labourers throughout the day
- (e) Some workers were hired at the last hour of the day

3. The payment of the labourers

- (a) Out of the generosity of the Vineyard Owner he gave the workers that came in late a full day's pay
- (b) The workers that had worked the whole day expected to be paid more, but they also received the same amount of money
- (c) They were unhappy that they were not paid more!

4. This prompted a comment from the Lord

- (a) Many assume that they deserved more
- (b) Those who did not even expect to be asked to work were very happy they were paid at all!
- (c) The joy of being called to serve should not be lost!
- (d) The danger of losing this sense of joy after serving for some time is very real!
