MISSIONS MINISTRY

Thank God for grace and strength for another week of ministry in Myanmar (5-9 June 2017).

- 1. The present strength of BTS (Yangon) is 86 students
- 2. Many denominations have sent their students into our school
- 3. Many challenges to the teachers here to equip and train the new students over the next 4 years!
