Praise the LORD!

Praise the LORD! O my soul!

While I live I will praise the LORD; I will sing praises to my God while I have my being.

Psalm 146:1-2

HOW WE MAY RESIST TAKING THINGS FOR GRANTED

Let us look at some of the insights the Psalmist offered in this Psalm.

- 1. Praise the LORD
 - a) He was determined to offer praise to the Lord
 - b) He desired to offer soul-praise to God!
 - c) Thus he repeats himself, "Praise the LORD!"
- 2. While I live I will praise the LORD
 - a) While I live
 - i) There was a special sense of awareness of the precious gift of life on earth
 - ii) But this life on earth will not last forever
 - iii) There will come a time when it will cease
 - iv) We only have the "here and now"
 - v) He determined that as long as he lived, he will offer soulpraise to God
 - b) While I have my being

- i) This statement heightens the sense of consciousness of having but a short time on earth
- ii) This life on earth is perhaps far shorter than we realise
- 3. I will sing praises to my God while I have my being
 - a) There was a very great sense of relating to the Lord (Note the phrase "my God")
 - b) This close relationship with God only served to motivate the Psalmist to offer heartfelt songs of praise
 - c) Thus Psalm 146 was written
 - i) As a personal example
 - ii) With a desire to encourage others to make their earthly life be filled with songs of praise to the Lord

LET US SEEK TO DEEPEN OUR UNDERSTANDING OF LIFE ON EARTH

Let us seek to deepen our understanding of our brief sojourn on earth. Before too long, our life on earth will come to an end. Let us be inspired to live a life that is characterised by praise given to God!

- 1. The seven lampstands
 - a) These symbolised the Seven Churches mentioned in Revelation 2-3
 - b) The symbol of gold
 - i) It highlights its worth
 - ii) A reminder of what the church is and should always be
 - c) The symbol of Lampstands
 - i) A symbol of light
 - ii) The church must ever seek to bear light
- 2. The Lord Jesus Christ
 - a) He is featured as "The Son of Man"
 - i) Christ's favourite description of Himself in His identification with mankind
 - ii) It was also a significant Messianic title (Cf. Daniel 7:13)
 - b) He was walking amidst the Seven churches
 - i) He was in close touch with the churches
 - ii) This was reminiscent of the time He walked in Galilee with His disciples
