The challenge of being one as a church

"Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy" Phil 2:1

NB...clusters of words

- 1. Gal 5:22,23... use of comma
- 2. Phil 2:1...use of "ifs"

Powerful reasons for us to be one

1. Consolation in Christ

- a. παράκλησις ... paraklesis... come alongside, comfort, exhort (2 Cor 1)
- b. Exhortation in Christ
- c. Christ is central to all

2. Comfort of love

- a. παραμύθιον... paramuthion... consolation, comfort
- b. ἀγάπης... agape...love...
- i. Paul has the brethren in his heart (Phil 1:7)
- ii. He demonstrated love and consolation to the brethren...love from the Lord

3. Fellowship of the Spirit

- a. κοινωνία ... koinonia... fellowship, sharing
- b. Fellowship of the Spirit
- i. Fellowship between Paul and the brethren from the first day until then (Phil 1:5)
- ii. In fellowship, the Father and the Lord Jesus are involved (1 John 1:3)
- iii. The Holy Spirit is involved in deep and meaningful fellowship.

4. Affection

- a. σπλάγχνα...splangna...affection, inner most feeling
- b. A reference to the affection of Jesus... (Phil 1:8)

5. Mercy

- a. οἰκτιρμοί... oiktirmoi... mercy, compassion, pity...
- i. eleeo ... to show mercy, compassion... (Phil 2:27)
- ii. oiktirmoi... a deeper and more tender kind of mercy than eleeo
- b. The challenge to show mercy to others

The personal plea of Paul for oneness

"fulfil my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind." Phil 2:2

1. The plea to fulfil his joy

- a. πληρώσατέ... plaroeo...fulfil
- b. χαράν... chara...grace, joy

2. The exhortation to be one

a. Same mind

- i. τὸ αὐτὸ ...the same
- ii. φρονῆτε... phroneo...think, mindset
- iii. To have the same thinking as Paul

b. Same love

- i. τὴν αὐτὴν... the same
- ii. ἀγάπην ... agape...love
- iii. Having the same love

c. One spirit

- i. σύνψυχοι... sumpsuchos... adjective...same spirit, likeminded
- ii. Being of one accord

d. One mind

- i. φρονοῦντες, ... phroneo... exercise the mind
- ii. Think only one thing
