1. God's Covenant with Noah

Genesis 9:9-11

- a) And as for Me
 - i) God's covenant reflects who the Lord is!
 - ii) Our focus should be the Lord
 - iii) Rather than the recipient... Man
- b) My covenant
 - i) This is important to note
 - ii) Let us be reminded that all covenants are the Lord's!
 - iii) They originate from Him

Dear Brethren,

HONOURING OUR PARENTS

The Biblical injunction is very clear. We are to honour our parents. This was laid down as the Fifth Commandment (Cf. Exodus 20:12).

The Apostle Paul took time to teach how this Commandment was to be applied.

1. In the biological family

Paul wrote to encourage the Ephesians to practise this within the biological family Ephesians 6:1–3

2. He went on to apply this Commandment in the non-biological family. The context is obviously the church.

"Do not rebuke an older man, But exhort him as a father..." 1 Timothy 5:1

OUR LUNCH FELLOWSHIP

We have several hundred people staying back for Lunch Fellowship on Sunday afternoons. If we take a careful look in Church we would notice the following: –

- 1. We have more wheel-chair bound people
- 2. We have a growing number of people who are senior citizens (65 years and above)
- 3. Here is the challenge for us to consider practising:
 - a) We will have a Priority Queue for our senior citizens
 - b) In the case of those who are much older, family members may queue up on their behalf
 - c) We will have a section which will be reserved for our senior citizens
 - d) Let us seek to put into practise the Biblical injunction about honouring parents
