 - iii) And will bring you back to this land
 - iv) I will never leave you
- b) These were powerful and precious promises from the Lord

Dear Brethren,

BEARING MUCH FRUIT FOR THE LORD

At the Junior Camp, the following poem was shared with the Camp Officers.

THAT YOU BEAR MUCH FRUIT

Bearing fruit is a teaching we do well to take heed; There are vital truths that Jesus taught that are deep. He desires His Disciples to bear much fruit in ministry; The Father is glorified when fruit is seen in quantity.
