The purpose of Paul's writing

"For me to write the same things to you is not tedious, but for you it is safe." (Phil 3:1)

- 1. Γραφειν... grapho... to write... Infinitive of purpose
- 2. For Paul, he had to reiterate certain things in his writings
- 3. It was not tedious for Paul to write the same things
- 4. aσφαλες... asphales... alpha privative + sphales... failing, fall... secure, sure...
- a. Not to fall but to be safe and secured
- b. In the view of false teachers and false teachings.

Warning against false teachers

"Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the mutilation!" (Phil 3:2)

- 1. Βλεπετε... blepo... I see, look...
- 2. 3 times this word is used... much emphasis and seriousness
- 3. Three aspects of the false teachers
- a. Dogs
- b. Evil workers
- c. κατατομην... katatome... cutting down, mutilation

A reference to the Jewish believers

"For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh," (Phil 3:3)

- 1. We are the circumcision
- a. περιτομη... peritome... circumcision, to cut around
- b. A reference to Jewish believers

- 2. Worship of God in the Spirit (John 4:24)
- 3. Rejoice in Christ Jesus
- 4. No confidence in the flesh
- a. πεποιθοτες... peitho... convinced, persuaded... perfect active participle
- b. Use of the perfect

Paul's pedigree

- 1. Paul compared his pedigree as a Jew to the Judaizers.
- 2. Paul once had confidence in the flesh... of following the law "though I also might have confidence in the flesh." (Phil 3:4)
- a. εχων... echo... have...
- b. πεποιθησιν... pepoithesis... trust, confidence
- 3. There was no one who could compare with him concerning his confidence in the flesh "If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the flesh, I more so:" (Phil 3:4)
- 4. A description of Paul's confidence in the flesh (Phil 3:5–6)
- a. The rite of circumcision"Circumcised the eighth day"
- b. Jewish ancestry
- i. Part of the nation of Israel
- "of the stock of Israel"
- ii. From the tribe of Benjamin
- "of the tribe of Benjamin"
- iii. He was a true-blue Hebrew
- "Hebrew of the Hebrews"
- c. Concerning the law "concerning the law, a Pharisee;"
- concerning the law, a I harrsee,
- d. Concerning zeal
- "concerning zeal, persecuting the church;"
- e. Concerning the righteousness of the law
- "concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless."
