The things counted loss for Christ

- 1. The things that were previously gained to Paul
- "But what things were gain to me," (Phil 3:7)
- a. Άλλà... conjunction... a contrast
- b. A reference to all the things that Paul had achieved as a Jew
- c. κερδη... kerdos... gain
- 2. Counted as loss for Christ
- "these I have counted loss for Christ." (Phil 3:7)
- a. Paul deemed his past heritage as loss
- i. ηγημαι... hegeomai... deem, consider, count (Accounting term)
- ii. ζημιαν... zemia... damage, loss
- b. For the sake of Christ
- 3. For Paul, all things counted as loss "Yet indeed I also count all things loss..." (Phil 3:8)
- a. $\alpha\lambda\lambda\alpha...$ conjunction... but, yet
- b. μενουν... particle... truly, indeed
- c. και...conjunction...and, also
- d. Use of hegeomai again
- e. All things...not just his heritage but all things
- f. With regards to all things, Paul continues to regard them as loss

- 4. Suffering the loss
- "for whom I have suffered the loss of all things," (Phil 3:8)
- a. For Christ (cf. Phil 3:7)
- b. εζημιωθην... zemioo... damage, suffer loss
- c. For Christ that Paul had suffer this loss
- 5. Regarded as rubbish
- "and count them as rubbish," (Phil 3:8)
- a. Third time that hegeomai is used
- b. σκυβαλα... skubalon...refuse, dung, rubbish
- c. He deemed all things as rubbish

The things that would be gained for Christ

- 1. The excellence of the knowledge of Christ
- "for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord," (Phil 3:8)
- a. δια... dia... preposition...through, for the sake of
- b. το υπερεχον... ho huperecho... definite article... the... to hold above, to excel
- c. Paul was striving for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ
- 2. To gain Christ Himself
- "that I may gain Christ..." (Phil 3:8)
- a. wa...hina... conjunction...that, in order to...purpose
- b. κερδησω... kerdaino... gain, win, profit
- c. The purpose of gaining Christ
