- a. It is not just about knowledge... gnosis
- b. It is about Christ Himself
- c. It has to do with the person and the knowledge of the person

Identification with Christ

- 1. The challenge to be found in Christ "and be found in Him," (Phil 3:9)
- a. εύρεθω... heurisko... find, obtain
- b. ἐν αὐτῷ... autos... personal pronoun... him...
- 2. Basis salvation in Christ
- a. Not the righteousness of the law "not having my own righteousness, which is from the law," (Phil 3:8)
- b. The righteousness of faith in Christ "but that which is through faith in Christ," (Phil 3:9)
- c. Through faith in Christ (Salvation)
- d. By faith
- "the righteousness which is from God by faith;" (Phil 3:9)
- i. Righteousness is found from God
- ii. επι τη πιστει... on the basis of the faith... by faith

The pursuit of Paul for his life

- "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death," (Phil 3:10)
- 1. "that I may know Him," (Phil 3:10)

- a. του γνῶναι... ho ginosko... know
- b. To grow in our knowledge of Christ... (cf. Phil 3:8)
- 2. The power of His resurrection

"and the power of His resurrection," (Phil 3:10)

- a. τὴν δύναμιν... ho dunamis... the power
- b. τῆς ἀναστάσεως ... ho anastasis... the resurrection
- c. Paul described this power further (1 Cor 15)
- 3. The fellowship of His sufferings
- "and the fellowship of His sufferings,
- a. καὶ... kai... and...
- b. την κοινωνίαν... ho koinonia... the fellowship
- c. των παθημάτων... ho pathema... of His death... genitive plural neuter
- i. Paul sought to know the fellowship of the suffering of Christ
- ii. Paul sought to be identified with His suffering
- 4. Conforming to His death
- "being conformed to His death," (Phil 3:10)
- a. συμμορφιζόμενος... summorphoo... sun... with... morphe... form... to render like, to assimilate into the same form...
- b. To His death
- i. Paul was identifying with the death of Christ
- ii. He was willing to go to the point of death for Christ

Attaining the resurrection from the dead

"if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead." (Phil 3:11)

- 1. εἴ πως
- 2. καταντήσω... katantao... to attain, to arrive at
- a. Paul sought to attain the resurrection of the dead
- b. This was his purpose
- 3. Into the resurrection of the dead
