Jesus sought to correct their wrong ideas and their misgivings; But the learning seemed to be so hard, they were not discerning. The wrong ideas had to be corrected, or they would affect adversely; Jesus had to do a cleansing work and it must be done thoroughly.

The things that Jesus taught when fully understood will bring Joy; This Joy has so much depth and yet it is without any alloy. The heart must be challenged to consider again what Jesus taught; This Joy that Jesus promised need not prove elusive, it may be caught!
