David was inspired to write many Psalms. The inspiration may be found in the words he wrote as he wrote Psalm 18.

I will love You, O LORD, my strength

The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies. Psalm 18:1-3

- 1. Discovery of the greatness of the Lord
 - a) He gives strength
 - b) He is a rock
 - c) He is a fortress
 - d) He is a deliverer
 - e) He is a shield
 - f) He is the horn of salvation ("horn" a symbol of power)
 - g) He is a stronghold

Dear Brethren,

SUSTAINING THE SPIRIT OF JOY AND PRAISE

One of the most challenging things to do is to sustain the spirit of joy and praise. How we actually and practically do that?

TAKE TIME TO READ THE SCRIPTURES

One of the ways we can sustain this spirit of joy and praise is to set aside time to read the Lord's Word profitably. We learn much about how to sustain this spirit of joy from Psalm 100.

The Psalmist sought to encourage all worshippers to do the following things:

- 1. Elements of Joy
 - a) With a joyful shout
 - b) To serve with gladness
 - c) To come into the Lord's presence with singing
 - d) To enter into His gates with thanksgiving
 - e) And into His courts with praise
- 2. Appreciating our relationship with God
 - a) To know the Lord as our God better
 - b) To remember Him as our Maker
 - c) To appreciate that we are His people and the sheep of His pasture
- 3. Appreciating who the Lord is and what He has done for us
 - a) The LORD is good
 - b) His mercy is everlasting
 - c) His truth endures to all generations
- 4. Learning to be thankful

This is well-expressed when we are able to bless His name.

Let us be challenged to keep learning how we may sustain our spirit of joy and praise.
