Dear Brethren,

A NEW SERIES OF PULPIT MESSAGES

We begin a new series of Pulpit Messages today. This series will lead us to meditate on the Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour. It would lead us and help us appreciate the significance of Easter.

BEHOLD! MY SERVANT

The LORD God had always wanted Israel to exemplify what it means to be His servant. But Israel has never lived up to any kind of expectations. Instead, Israel went the opposite way and turned to idolatry instead!

Was it really that difficult for Israel to be a true and faithful servant of God? The answer lay in the Messiah! He would exemplify to Israel and to all believers that it is possible to relate to God as His faithful servant.

THE GLORIOUS EXAMPLE OF JESUS AS A SERVANT OF GOD
