- 1. State enemies
 - a) There were hostile neighbours

- c) They engaged in battles from time to time
- 2. Personal enemies
 - a) These could be friends who became enemies
 - b) These could be enemies pretending to be friends
 - c) Either way they caused much grief

THE PRESENCE OF GOD

David learned an important spiritual truth as he increased in knowledge and faith. He learned how to treasure the Presence of God. His fears of enemies were dealt with when he learned this great truth.

> Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered, Let those also who hate Him flee before Him.

As smoke is driven away; So drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, So let the wicked perish at the presence of God.

But let the righteous be glad; Let them rejoice before God; Yes, let them rejoice exceedingly. Psalm 68:1-3
