Sing to God, sing praises to His name; Extol Him who rides on the clouds, By His name YAH, And rejoice before Him.

A father of the fatherless, a defender of widows, Is God in His holy habitation.

God sets the solitary in families; He brings out those who are bound into prosperity; But the rebellious dwell in a dry land. Psalm 68:4-6

- 1. Sing to God, sing praises to His name
 - a) This is a call or an exhortation to sing joyously to the Lord
 - b) This should be a natural response of the heart
- 2. Extol Him who rides on the clouds
 - a) This was an attempt to describe the majesty of God
 - b) Imagine anyone riding on clouds!
- 3. His name YAH, and rejoice before Him
 - a) The written form is YAH but it is to be pronounced "LORD"
 - b) This was the old Jewish way of referring to God
 - c) He was the One who must not be named

- d) Any meditation of the Lord should cause the heart to rejoice in Him
- 4. A brief word of appreciation of the works of God
 - a) He is a father of the fatherless
 - b) He is a defender of the widows
 - c) He sets those who are solitary (e.g. orphans) in families
 - d) Those who are bound He grants prosperity
 - e) The rebellious receive their just reward
 - f) They will live in a dry land!

19 MAY 2019 SENIOR PASTOR: REV DR CHARLES TAN

Dear Brethren,

THE STORY OF LEGION

The story of Legion and how the Lord Jesus cast out many demons from him was recorded in the synoptic Gospels (Matthew 8:28–34; Mark 5:1–20; Luke 8:26–39). After he was restored by the Lord Jesus, he asked if he could follow Him and be a disciple like the Twelve. What the Lord said to him was most significant. He did not allow Legion to be a disciple. He had just an important task for him to attempt and to fulfil.

Go home to your friends, And tell them what great things The Lord has done for you, And how He has had compassion on you.

Mark 5:19

- 1. Go home to your friends
 - a) The NKJV translation is not the best here
 - b) The literal translation reads:
 - i) Go to your house (home)
 - ii) To those in your home (translated as "your friends")
 - iii) The direct focus was not friends but family
 - iv) Friends are not excluded but the direct word to Legion was those in his household
- 2. The task of evangelism
 - a) The challenge of winning souls was not the responsibility of:
 - i) The Lord Jesus Christ
 - ii) Nor the Twelve Disciples
 - b) The challenge to bear witness was given to Legion!
 - c) This is a vital lesson that we must take heed
- 3. The challenge of bearing witness to family members
 This is a responsibility the Lord has given to ALL believers! We must seek to bear witness to members
 of our own household!
