2. Similar language

- b) Most notable is Psalm 103 where the idea of God's benefits are further elaborated on

3. Daily loads us with benefits

- c) The focus here that is amazing is the phrase "daily loads"
 - i) The blessings of God are many
 - ii) They are also given daily!

HAPPY "FATHER'S DAY"

Thank God for His grace given. A month ago, we celebrated "Mother's Day." Today we celebrate "Father's Day." The gift of parents is often not fully appreciated.

WISDOM FROM THE BOOK OF PROVERBS

The Book of Proverbs offers many excellent proverbial insights of life.

When I was my father's son, Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother,

He also taught me, and said to me: Let your heart also retain my words; Keep my commands and live.

Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore, get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding. Proverbs 4:3-4, 6

- 1. Remembering the words of our father
 - a) These words of wisdom given are worth remembering
 - b) They were remembered by Solomon
- 2. Asking for wisdom from God
 - a) Once God came to Solomon and offered him a special boon
 - b) God would grant him whatever boon he requested
 - c) Solomon asked for wisdom
 - d) How did he know what to ask?
 - e) It is likely that he had learned about the gift of wisdom from his father, David Hence, he asked for wisdom as his request from the LORD (1 Kings 3)
- 3. Wisdom: the principal thing
 - a) Wisdom and understanding go together
 - b) May we always desire and search for wisdom always
