THE PROFOUND HEAVENLY CALLING

There is a wonderful Heavenly Call from the Lord. We read about this in the following text.

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, Consider the Apostle and High Priest Of our confession, Christ Jesus, who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, As Moses was faithful in all His house. Hebrews 3:1

- 1. Consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession
 - a) Jesus is our Perfect Example of how to respond to God's heavenly calling
 - b) Our challenge is to comprehend how He responded to God's calling
- 2. Features:
 - a) Jesus was appointed by His Father
 - b) He was sent by God as "Apostle"
 - c) He was to function as "High Priest"
- 3. How did Jesus perform as He responded to the Heavenly Calling?
 - a) He was found "faithful"
 - b) His ministry was very difficult
 - i) But He was faithful
 - ii) He did not flinch from fulfilling His Divine appointment
- 4. Our Challenge
 - a) As partakers of the same Heavenly Calling
 - b) To learn how to be faithful to the LORD who has saved and called us to serve Him.
