In the gospels, there were great multitudes who followed the Lord, But many did not understand Him and never became true sons of God. When Paul commended Timothy as one who had followed carefully, He spoke of an outstanding spiritual son who loved the Lord truly.

These things were exemplary, specific and evident in the life of Paul,
These things became Timothy's pattern to live for the Lord above all.

We are challenged to consider how Timothy followed Paul so wonderfully, He was like-minded as Paul, and such closeness did not come by easily. Timothy did not seek his own and like Paul, his focus was solely the Lord, He was a proven faithful son, who served with Paul in the gospel of God.

Lovingly, Paul gave a further word of instruction and reminder to Timothy, He had learnt the Scriptures since young and he must press on faithfully. Timothy would keep this word close to his heart for he was a true son, He would persevere to the end, just as his spiritual father had done.
