We write to express our gratitude for the love outpoured towards u s as we grieved the passing of our beloved Ah Ma.

What kind of love is Bethany's love?

First, it is a love expressed not "in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth": 1 John 3:18. This verse will from now on be annotated with the image of you setting up the AV equipment, distributing bulletins in Ah Ma's garden, directing traffic in the rain, sheltering Ah Ma's family and friends to her home before the first vigil service, and coming out in force. The same verse will also call to remembrance the truth lovingly shared by Pastor Charlie from the porch of Ah Ma's home, and Hall 2 of Mandai Crematorium. The truth which assures us that the Lord had long ago prepared a dwelling place for Ah Ma, and came to receive her to Himself on 26 October 2019. We are greatly comforted by this truth.

Secondly, Bethany's love is a *sui generis*, self-sacrificial love. It is a love which calls to mind the Lord's commandment in John 13:34, "... that you love one another, <u>as I have loved you</u>". You love as Jesus loves. You sacrificed your treasured public-holiday rest; time with young children, aged parents and grandparents; working hours and more. You gave generously, and self-sacrificially.

Finally, your love is a love which confirms that you are of God. When the family got together after the funeral, cousin Kelvin spontaneously observed, "We can really see God's work through them."

A SERIES OF DEATHS

We have experienced the passing away of three people whom we know in one short week. What are some lessons that we may learn from this week's experience? Psalm 90 comes to mind readily.

1. We are reminder of the brevity of life (history)

"For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday when it is past, And like a watch in the night." Psalm 90:4

2. We are further reminded that human life is even briefer

"The days of our lives are seventy years; And if by reason of strength they are eighty years, Yet their boast is only labour and sorrow. It is soon cut off and we fly away" Psalm 90:10

3. Weeping with those who weep

It is good and right that we weep with those who weep. Let us continue to remember those who have suffered bereavement this past week.

THINGS THAT WE MUST CONSIDER PRAYING ABOUT

Let us consider praying with wisdom as the Lord's servant, Moses, teaches us:

1. Numbering our days

"So teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom" Psalm 90:12
