WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE ARE "SENSLESS?"

Psalm 92 offers an important insight when we are "senseless."

O LORD, how great are Your works! Your thoughts are very deep. A senseless person does not know Nor does a fool understand this.

Psalm 92:5-6

1. The works of God

- a) They are great indeed!
- b) The works of God are never shallow
- c) There is depth in everything that God does

2. A senseless person

- a) He may claim "knowledge"
- b) But can knowledge be obtained only intellectually?
- c) The person who is senseless:
 - i) He has not learned how to use his senses well
 - ii) He cannot claim knowledge fully if he is senseless

3. A fool

- a) The senseless person is also described as a fool
- b) He will never be able to have full understanding
- c) Yet, he may claim that using the senses that God has created is wrong
