THE DANGER OF FORGETTING

The danger was declared by Moses in the Book of Deuteronomy. It may be listed briefly thus:

- 1. Forgetting God
 - a) His acts of mercy
 - b) His provision
 - c) His protection
- 2. Creating idols for worship
 - a) This angers the Lord
 - b) This would result in enmity with the Lord

THINGS WORTH REMEMBERING

Two things were highlighted:

- 1. Remember His marvelous works 1 Chronicles 16:12
 - a) Some of them are of historic significance
 - b) Others are of a more personal nature
 - c) But none of them should be forgotten
- 2. Remember His covenant
 - a) God graciously gave to Abraham a wonderful covenant

- c) A covenant should be consciously remembered
