

- 1. Is this "End Times?"
 - a) There is an innate fear of "the end times"
 - b) This kind of fear is uncalled-for!
- 2. Is this "Divine judgment?"
 - a) Again, we see the problem of fear causing such questions to occur
 - b) We need to have a greater knowledge of how God dispenses divine justice
 - c) Let us not end up with:
 - i) Misgivings
 - ii) Misguided comprehension of God

2. Constructed

- b) Let us ever trust in God at all times, even in dire circumstances

4. Christ-centered

- a) Let us not lose our focus on the Lord Jesus Christ
- b) He is the center of all we are and all we do
