<sup>1</sup> Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous! For praise from the upright is beautiful. <sup>2</sup> Praise the LORD with the harp; Make melody to Him with an instrument of ten strings. <sup>3</sup> Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy. Psalm 33:1-3

- 1. This is a call to the righteous
  - a) To all who understand redemption
  - b) To all who appreciate the righteousness imputed to us
  - c) To all who seek to live for the Lord righteously
- 2. A call to rejoice in the LORD
  - a) There is every reason to rejoice in God
  - b) There is no good reason not to rejoice in the LORD
  - c) The challenge is to practise rejoicing in God

# AN APPRECIATION OF WHAT IT MEANS TO REJOICE IN THE LORD

Rejoicing in the Lord should cause us to offer praise to Him.

- 1. Praise from the upright
  - a) This is good and proper for the upright to practise
  - b) This is the right and natural thing to do

- 1. The use of musical instruments
  - a) This can add value to our songs of praise
  - b) It can add beauty and majesty
- 2. The composition of new songs

- 3. Playing skillfully
  - a) Let us seek to improve our skills
  - b) Let our hearts be committed to giving off our best to the Lord
