13 The pastures are clothed with flocks;
The valleys also are covered with grain;
They shout for joy, they also sing. Psalm 65:1-2, 11-13

- 3. A fresh sense of appreciation
 - a) Of a God who answers prayer
 - b) Of a God who has greatly blessed
