

THOSE WHO WALK IN THE STEPS OF FAITH

What did Paul mean when he wrote about walking in the steps of faith as Abraham did? Three "steps" may be considered:

- 1. Receiving righteousness of God by faith
 - a) Abraham received righteousness from God by faith Romans 4:13
 - b) This is the first step that we must take
 - i) We recognize we need to be justified by God
 - ii) Through faith we are declared righteous by God
 - iii) This is through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ

- 2. Recognizing the grace of God
 - a) Faith recognizes the grace of God

Romans 4:16

- b) We are justified by the grace given
- 3. Responding to the promises of God

Romans 4:17-22

- c) We hold fast though things may be contrary
- d) We do not waver in our faith
