

⁹ For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; ¹⁰ that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him*, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; ¹¹ strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; ¹² giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. ¹³ He has delivered us from the power of darkness and ©conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 1:9-14

IN THE CONTEXT OF PRAYER

- e) Strengthened with all might

3 Heirs of God


Having a Father in Heaven;

My father, Mr. Seow Tiong Quee, is 77 years old. He worked in a carpentry company for most of his life as an antique furniture painter and lived a simple and thrifty life.

During January 2019, my father experienced a heart attack on his way to the supermarket. However, by God's grace, he managed to bring himself to a nearby clinic and an ambulance was called. He was then admitted to a hospital and underwent a heart bypass operation during early February and spent Chinese New Year in the hospital. He was discharged soon after and had a swift recovery. By April, he was able to talk and walk without feeling breathless as he needed to "re-learn" to breathe normally after the operation.

My mother, Mdm Ang Jock Choo, is 68 years old. She started working as a domestic helper taking up 2 jobs to help with supporting the family. She later moved on to work as a shop assistant at a neighbourhood bakery shop.

During late 2016, she had a fall on her way to work early in the morning. We were unaware of her fall but within few weeks we realised she started to have problem walking.

We thought it could be her knee cap problem and brought her to the polyclinic where she was referred to see a specialist. Her condition started to deteriorate rapidly and very soon she was bed-ridden. However, with much encouragements and prayers, she finally agreed to go for the cervical neck operation which is a very high risk operation. By God's grace, the operation was successful but due to some complications she had to prolong her

stay to nearly 3 months before she can be transferred to a rehabilitation centre. After 1 month plus in the centre, she was finally allowed to be discharged. Miraculously, she too experienced a swift recovery and was able to walk with the use of a walking stick not long after.

During my parents' respective stays in the hospital, they experienced the love of God through friends from church who often visited and prayed for them. Their perception, especially my father's, towards Christianity begin to change. His "old thinking" of Christian as weak and religious people no longer existed but he is now more open to people praying for him. He witnessed the power of prayer first through my mother's encounter and later in his own when he encountered the heart attack.

On 13 Jan 2020, during our family weekly visit to my parent's place, I was sharing with them how God had helped them during their days in hospital and even during their recovery. They agreed and my father said he will be a Christian, but he needed more time. Not knowing what that meant at that time, in our few visit later we noticed all the idols at home were gone. He had removed them himself and shared with us that he wanted to have nothing to do with his past religion before he accepts Christ as his personal saviour.

We are thankful for all the prayers and support from friends and especially the people of Bethany whom my parents had interacted with during their visit to the multiple events at Bethany. They have mentioned that they felt the warmth of the people in Bethany and it makes them want to come to Church more often.

It is with great joy and thankfulness that they have expressed their desires to be baptised.

Mdm Tan Khey Mother of Iris Teo

My name is Tan Khey. I am 89 yrs old. I am a very simple, traditional woman who worshipped idols like Guan Yin and Guan Tek Ya. Being a widow for 40 years, I brought up 5 children (3 daughters, 1 adopted daughter and one son).

I enjoyed cooking nice food especially during Chinese New Year, like ngoh hiang, chili crab and curry chicken. Ever since my son passed away in 2017, I was left stranded without a place to stay. My daughter-in-law sold the flat. With the money she went back to China, leaving me in the lurch.

I became very sad and depressed. Everytime I talk about it, I would cry. Every few weeks, I had to move about between the homes of my two daughters. To overcome my grief and sadness, I followed my daughter, Iris Teo, to Bethany Church. I also attended Christmas and Easter events in Shangrila.

Many church people showed their concern with comforting words like Nancy Ang, Toong Su Yin, Juliana Chew, Carrie Kong, Florence and Joanna. They made me feel welcome in Church. I look forward in coming to Church to learn about the Lord Jesus.

One day, two sisters brought me out for lunch. There they shared the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ with me. Actually, I was very sad and felt hopeless. Upon hearing the love of God for me and how Jesus cared for my soul, I opened my heart to the Lord. I found great comfort to know that the God of the Bible loves me so much and gave His life for me. The Lord washed and forgave my sins. Now I have a hope in Heaven and a right relationship with the Lord which brings peace.

I fell down twice - once in August 2019 and the other in October

2019. I was warded in TTSH, Sengkang Community Hospital and finally at Renci Community Rehab Hospital. Before knowing the Lord, I would be very upset. But knowing the Lord made the difference. I prayed to Him for His help to make me well and strength to do the physio. Though I was not able to move much, I experienced the love and concern from quite a few church members who came to cheer me - like Lay See, Li Kum, Dao Hong, and Jeremy Ng. God's children visited me with gifts and encouraging words.

I am very touched and moved by the actions of Christians. They not only talk about love, but they showed God's love to me.

Although I may not remember all the truths shared with me, one thing I know is, that I can pray to God to make a way for me to cope with the challenges of life. Being a child of God, I have decided to declare my faith in baptism this Easter. Coming to faith in Jesus I am able to put my mind at ease, as I learn to pray to Jesus and talked to Him about my cares and worries. The Lord gives me His peace.

I also learned a song called "Khan Goa e Chiu." (Hold my hand) The Lord Jesus holding my hand gives me the confidence that I could walk strongly, and letting Him lead me all the way. I learn to trust in Jesus' promises. I am now very happy. Thank God for His people in Bethany who helped me to find faith in Jesus. I will follow the Lord all the way.

Mdm Lee Bee Geok Mother of Michael Chew

My name is Mdm Lee Bee Geok, better known as Michael Chew's mum. I am 67 years old and have three sons and 5 grandchildren. I was first introduced to Bethany IPC when Michael and Jillian invited me during one of the Christmas lunches many years ago. Through the years, I've attended many special lunches, worship services and kindergarten concerts. I have always felt the warmth and kindness of the members from Bethany.

Born into a Taoist family, I was brought up to follow my parents' instructions when it came to religious practices. When they told me to kneel, I kneeled; and when they told me to pray, I prayed. But deep down in my heart, these actions meant nothing to me. In fact, the religion instilled fear in me, especially the scary idols.

Despite my Taoist upbringing, most of my friends were Christians. They have always tried to convince me to convert to Christianity. Although I did not show any interest in the faith, deep down in my heart, there was always a place for Christ, the Lord. They always encouraged me to trust in God in all circumstances, but it was difficult to fully understand this. Often times at night, I would pray to Jesus and try to visualize Him. I always wondered why my Christian friends were so at peace with the Lord.

As I look back, I now see that the Lord was always speaking to me. When I turned to the obituary in the newspapers, I would especially like to read the Christian verses. My favorites are Psalm 23 and John 14:2. The idea of the Lord as Shepherd, and that He will prepare a place for His followers in Heaven was comforting.

I was diagnosed with stage 4 bile duct cancer in June 2019. There was fear, pain and discomfort from the immunotherapy. Many offered to pray for me, and shared verses to encourage me. I found much peace and comfort from this, and decided that I would like to be sent off a Christian when that day comes.

With the encouragement of Michael and Jillian, I started having weekly sessions with Pastor Charles earlier in the year. Through these weekly Zoom sessions, I am always encouraged by the verses shared. With a deeper understanding, I decided to accept the Lord wholeheartedly. In Him, I have found peace.

I hope that one day, my husband, children and grandchildren will also come to faith through my life experience and testimony.

The rest of my life is in God's hands. I know that as His child, I can experience His goodness and mercy. I can trust in Him to hold me by His right hand now and forever.
