

 - d) He read this portion of the Scriptures
 - e) He then went on to say that He had fulfilled the Scriptures
 - f) This particular text had to do with the Anointing of the Spirit of God

Dear Pastor Charlie, Pastoral Team and all at Bethany,

I am writing to express my heartfelt gratitude for your prayers and support towards my family during this difficult time. Thank you for your kindness shown all the times my family has come to Bethany. They often tell me that they feel so undeserving to have received such hospitality from the people in Bethany. A big "thank you" as well to the AV team once again for your efforts in setting up live streaming for many who could not be there at the Memorial Service. I would also like to thank Pastor who took time off from his busy schedule to meet up with my Dad (Mr. Henry Cheng Ah Bah) to reach out to him.

Thinking about how Dad came to faith in the Lord is something I cannot express in words because it was hard for him to even step into a Christian church. My Dad had been a Roman Catholic all his life, following his mother and his siblings. I used to go to an RC church with my family on Sundays and Dad used to tell us that he was incredibly happy to see us going to church together as a family. When I broke the news to them that I was going to attend Bethany, I remembered how extremely disappointed my Dad was, especially when I told him that I was going to be baptised in Bethany.

The following few months were one of the most difficult periods because he did not want to communicate with me, and the only thing I knew I could do at that moment was to live a new life that God had given to me and bear testimony to my family.

Eventually over the years, there were instances where Dad would offer me a lift to church on Sundays and this time to Bethany! I remember clarifying with him again and again about his offers to send me to

church because it was shocking, and I could not believe it. I do miss those short rides with Dad travelling from home to church where we would have simple conversations.

Fast forward to December last year (2020) when we received the news that Dad was diagnosed with a double cancer problem and that it was terminal, it was so hard to accept the news. In fact, I remembered Dad asking the doctor again and again whether there was anything that could save his life.

That day, I experienced his fears, his sadness, and his worries. He told me that he was not ready and that this was too sudden. He subsequently went on to look for answers, from the doctors, his family members, his friends but still had an unsettled heart.

At that point of time, watching him go through pain and suffering, and on top on that not being able to find peace and comfort within the heart – this broke my heart.

I decided to ask if he would like to meet up with Pastor for just a word of encouragement. I honestly was not expecting a positive response from him, but to my surprise, he agreed.

My dad was getting weaker as each day passed by, yet he looked forward to meet with Pastor for the second time and even a third. When we went for these sessions, I saw the great amount of effort that Dad was willing to make - first he was able to walk using an umbrella for support, subsequently he needed to use a walking frame and then eventually a wheelchair.

Truly the Lord has been so gracious and merciful. Without the Lord's help, I knew that Dad would not have been able to have the strength and determination to meet up with Pastor.

upon reflection and as I look back at the past two months since he was told that he was at the end stage of his life, I truly thank God with joy and gratitude within my heart that Dad had come to faith in Him. Cancer took dad away faster than what was expected but the last few moments of his life was one of the best.

Somehow during those three short sessions with Pastor, the word of God had reached deep into Dad's heart and soul. He had found strength and assurance that no one else was able to give - not his friends or family members and not even the RC priest. The truth of God's Word had set my dad free and he was able to see beyond this life. One of the verses that Pastor shared with my dad had impacted him deeply:

"Most assuredly, I say to you,
he who **hears** My word and **believes** in Him who sent Me
has everlasting life,
and shall not come into judgment, but has
passed from death into life."
John 5:24

There was peace within Dad's heart because there was perfect understanding of God's truth of redemption and salvation. Dad believed in God's promises of everlasting life, not coming into judgment and passing from death into a new life.

Dad had experienced God's lovingkindness in the most challenging time of his life and because of this, there were no more fears but faith that enabled him to say that he was ready to meet with the Lord.
