

### TESTIMONY OF AUNTY LINDA KUA

Dear brethren from Bethany,

#### A MAJOR SET-BACK

I am Linda Kua. It has been my privilege to be a part of our beloved Bethany family for more than 20 years. I am thankful to God for the gift of the Church family.

In 2018, I faced a major setback in life. My husband, Then Ah Sam, was diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer. The news came as a shock to us. It felt like our whole world was rocked. During the time of helplessness, God reminded us to look to Him.

Psalm 121:1-2
I will lift up my eyes to the hills
From whence comes my help?
My help comes from the Lord,
Who made heaven and earth.

As the children of Israel made their pilgrimage to Jerusalem, they kept their eyes on the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. For all they did not know in the journey, they trusted the Lord, their true help. These verses held us steady through our journey with cancer. There were difficult challenges along the way but as we lifted our eyes to the eternal hills, our hearts were lifted too.

The doctor did not recommend any treatment for my husband's cancer as it was too far advanced. Without God, it would have seemed hopeless. But we were not without help. Whether in the hospital or at home, we could feel God's presence with us. What we took for granted in the past became very precious. Because we did not know how long we had, we lived appreciatively.

#### THE GRACE OF GOD

By God's grace, those days were lived with patience, love, laughter, tears and hope. The doctor told us our days together were limited, but God gave us a full year together.

On 27 November 2018, in the Lord's best timing, He called my husband Home to be with Him.

#### A DEEP VALLEY

A new chapter of my life began. I had never thought about what it would be like to be a widow, and how I would cope with the sadness and loneliness. Also, four months into the bereavement, I lost my job of more than 30 years.

This double blow made me fall into a deep valley. I became spiritually disoriented and started spiraling down. Tears flowed freely. During this time, because of the coronavirus outbreak, I felt even more isolated and alone. The doctor feared that I might be going through a depression.

But God is faithful. He does not give up on His own. One day, I was listening to a Chinese Christian broadcast when these words hit me: "When in the valley, do not pity yourself. The more you feel sorry for yourself, the more you can't get up. Look up to our great Savior and find hope in Him!"

These words woke me up and got me thinking about the self-pity that I had been wallowing in. My tears for myself had made me blind to truths that mattered. I had forgotten and even doubted the love and faithfulness of God. I had trusted my doubt-filled perceptions of reality instead of the certainty of God's promises in the Word that I treasured.

That night, I knelt before God in complete honesty and humility. Although I had often "prayed" during those dark months, deep down, I knew I was

#### GOD IN CONTROL AGAIN

In contrition, I confessed to God that I truly disliked my sorrowful and hopeless life. Having reached the end of the road, I surrendered myself to God and no longer wanted to let the "person in me" control me. I pleaded with Him to save me, change me and take control of my mind and heart.

Though I did not know how help was coming, I was assured that the Lord would come. For He had said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Hebrews 13:5

At that time, the Morning Worship messages from Psalm 36 also moved me deeply. Through Pastor Charlie's preaching from the text, I learnt again to see God's mercy and faithfulness.

"Your mercy, O Lord, is in the heavens;
Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.
Your righteousness is like the great mountains;
Your judgments are a great deep;
O Lord, You preserve man and beast.
How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God!
Therefore the children of men put their trust
under the shadow of Your wings.
They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house,
And You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures.
For with You is the fountain of life;
In Your light we see light."
Psalm 36:5-9

These verses put faith in my heart and clarity in my focus. They helped me keep my eyes on who God is. Thanks be to God! I could pray for my children and grandchildren again. I could visit friends and cook soup for those in need. I could look to God and live again!

"In Your light, we see light." This is a beautiful promise to all who are the Lord's. With His light, there will be no darkness! We will see light even in the darkest valley.
