This Christmas is special to us because God has given us a precious gift - Elijah! Our hearts are filled with joy as we welcome our son into this world. We are so grateful as we trace God's hand of protection throughout the pregnancy and delivery.

We had to learn how to commit our little one to God in prayer from the very onset when we found out that we were expecting. Our doctors warned that we were at risk of complications because of a congenital condition where there is reduced blood flow in Steph's abdomen. Whenever there were uncertainties and fears creeping up on us, we were challenged to put our trust in our sovereign God. This was exactly the lesson we needed to learn from the pulpit theme in January 2022 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." (Proverbs 3:5-6). Each time we went for a checkup, we were relieved when our doctor told us that Elijah was developing well. Truly, God was protecting him!

When we finally held our newborn baby in our hands and examined his little hands and feet, we were simply in awe of God's creation. This Christmas, we gain a fresh appreciation of the gift of eternal life that God has given to us through the birth of the Lord Jesus. We thank God for the life we can have in and through Christ. We have every reason to be joyful not just because we are new parents but as we have found inspiration and purpose in our lives through our Saviour's birth.

We named our son Elijah and it means "the LORD is my God". Our hope is that Elijah will come to discover our God just as we have found Him to be so real and personal in our lives. We are deeply conscious that Elijah belongs to the Lord and we are just given the privilege of being God's instruments to love and care for him! Through baptism, we commit ourselves to bringing him up in a Christian home that fears the Lord, and to sharing God's gift of salvation and joy with him. Our prayer is that Elijah will experience the grace of God so that he may one day grow up to become a person who will love and glorify Him.



Joining the Bethany family

We started attending Bethany since 2018 and were deeply drawn by the Bethany spirit. There was such a great sense of love for God and for one another; a desire to grow in knowledge and in faith; and immense joy and dedication in serving, whether young or old. We have experienced the warmth and genuine love of the Bethany family in more ways than one, as a whole and especially through individuals. Keith's journey with God

As a second-generation Christian, my spiritual journey followed a gentle upward climb, albeit many dips along the way. But I thank God that "He who has begun a good work in [me] will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ." – Philippians 1:6. I started attending church at the age of 3 years, but it was not till my later teens that I began to take my Christian walk more seriously. Over the years, fruit-bearing was a gradual process – little by little, God was changing me.

My life was smooth-sailing for the most part, until the Lord called my father home to be with Him when I was just 14 years old. Needless to say, I had many questions, doubts and fears; but God proved Himself to be real and faithful. Time and time again, He reassured my family that He would provide, that He would never leave us nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). And as He promised, so He did. "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." – Philippians 4:19. How precious it was to be able to experience His never-changing faithfulness. Indeed, "Great is Thy faithfulness! Great is Thy faithfulness! Morning by morning new mercies I see; All I have needed thy hand hath provided. Great is thy faithfulness, Lord unto me!"

Throughout my journey thus far, God has taught me so many precious lessons – through perceived failure, waiting on the Lord, God's miraculous answers to prayer and instances in which God blessed me above and beyond what I asked for or im-

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agined (Ephesians 3:20). There are still so many ways in which I fall short of God's standard, so much unfinished work within me for my Master, and so much stumbling along the way; but "I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to him until that Day." – 2 Timothy 1:12. Indeed, I owe all that I am to the One who has been faithfully walking alongside me, and it is my prayer and desire to faithfully serve Him and be His instrument of blessing to the people around me, by His grace and for His glory.

Pei Ling's journey with God

I was born into a loving non-believing family of five. Growing up, life was simple. However, in my teenage years, I began asking myself questions. "What is life, truly?" "Am I good enough?" "Is life all about studies?" During those seasons, I found a temporal sense of security in other places, e.g., having a vibrant social life, earning man's approval, seeking popularity. As the years passed, I realised that these things did not matter at all. What truly mattered then?

In His own divine plan and timing, the Lord graciously placed individuals in my life who shared Christ with me and taught me precious truths from the Bible. Through testimonies of God's faithfulness in their lives, I began to experience a growing interest to know the God of the Bible. I was presented with Ephesians 2.8-9: "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God." At that point, I could not comprehend why good works could not lead me to Heaven. I had been to church and had heard the gospel many times, but there was no conviction in my heart. By God's grace, at the age of 19 years, following a gospel message at a Youth Rally, the Holy Spirit revealed John 3: 16 – 18 to me in a very personal and special way. I came to the foot of the Cross, confessed my sins and asked the Lord Jesus to be my Saviour. Knowing that my past, present and future sins have been washed away by the Blood of the Lamb gave me tremendous inward peace; and knowing that I was a new person in Christ gave me much courage, light and hope.

As I grow older, I realise how much of a work in progress I am. Following Jesus is a day-to-day journey and not a one-time event. My walk with Jesus has not been a bed of roses. More times than ever, I have had to make intentional decisions to deny myself, take up the cross and follow Him. I am thankful that I can always find grace at the foot of the cross! "This is my story, this is my song, praising my Saviour all the day long." May I trust the Author to pen His story in my life!

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Ambassadors of Christ to our children

God has blessed us with two lovely sons, Nathan and Caleb. They are such precious gifts from above, yet we know that they do not belong to us, for we are merely ambassadors of Christ entrusted with the role of raising them for His purpose. One lesson that has stood out is the need to surrender our children to the very One who created them. Through hiccups during the pregnancy and delivery, challenges along the way and fears and anxieties about the future, we recognized how difficult it was to put this into practice. How blessed it is to know that our sovereign God is in control. He knows best and He makes no mistake!

Being parents of two boys, we recognize God's unseen hand of protection daily! Missing a sharp object by a few centimetres during a fall; missing a toppling motorcycle on the pavement by a few seconds; being spared from injuries during a car accident – these are just a few of the many instances where God's protection upon our children has been so real to us. Indeed, God's angels are constantly watching over our little ones!

We are thankful that our children can be part of this everlasting covenant that was first established with Abraham. We recognize that we as parents are responsible as God's tools to raise them up in the fear of God, and in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 
Households of Faith (Family and Church)

Hello everyone! We are Yinzhou and Aleena, parents to Zyon Cai (蔡芥信cài jìe xìn), our almost ten-month-old son.

Zyon is a precious gift from the Lord to us, and we have witnessed the Lord's loving presence and abundant blessing upon our family throughout our journey of parenthood thus far. From the pregnancy, delivery and now as we face challenges that come with being new parents in this season of life, God has shown us grace upon grace. Despite our fears and weaknesses, we see Him lovingly equipping us with the sensitivity, skills and strength to care for our little boy.

Zyon was named after our prayer and hope for him. "Zyon" is derived from the word "Zion", which in the Bible signifies not only God's presence, but also the eternal spiritual kingdom of God. It is our prayer that Zyon will grow to find God's presence real in his life and have a "kingdom mindset" - where his mind is set on things above, and not on things on earth.

Greetings Bethany! I am Elaine. My daughter, Freya, and I attend Bethany.

Today marks a new chapter of my life. I started coming to Bethany in June 2016. (I brought Freya along a few months later.) Just like everyone else, life is full of challenges, big or small.

Finding Faith and myself

I work in the Banking industry. In late 2014, I left a team of caring and supportive managers and colleagues for a better career opportunity, working in a Global Bank. I struggled adapting to the new environment and culture. I began to realise that relying solely on my own strength was not enough, I needed more. Something in me led me to seek God and I followed my sister to a Church which she attends. There, I found God's Word meaningful and guiding. His Word also comforted me. Although I started attending church with my sister, I felt something was still lacking. During a catch-up meal with my dear friend Yvonne, she once again invited me to Bethany. I attended her baptism here many years ago. She would always invite us to Bethany's Christmas lunch, but we were always caught up with our own plans. This time, I told her I would text her when I was ready and I did. I can only say that this was done according to His Timing and His will.

I am still in the same job. The challenges have not stopped. Accepting God does not mean that all the challenges we face will go away, As I learnt in God's Word, I know I need to further reflect on myself and to change. I used to go all out, do what is right and speak up.

I have learnt to put my faith in God. It is also through Him and the challenges that He has put before me that I have learnt to be patient and work alongside Him. I have come to trust that He has a plan for me. He is also moulding me to be a better person as I study His Word and try hard to apply them in my life.

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As I learn of God's Word, my faith grows stronger as I know through His wisdom and strength, I will have peace, comfort, and joy in my heart. Whenever I feel something bothering me at work, I would calm myself down as I remember His Word,

James 1:19-20

"So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God."

At home, my family have all been protected by Him. The past 2 years have been good, despite the fear of catching COVID. Working and studying at home have brought us closer. We spent more time together than pre-COVID, as I used to work late. Through God's timing, we caught COVID this year, myself, in March, followed by my husband, Nick in April. Freya caught it in October, just when her "O" level exams started, thus causing a bit of stress. Through God's grace, she recovered quickly and was out for her exams on the 5th day. My symptoms were mild while Nick had it quite serious with side effects lasting 6 weeks. Letting us catch COVID at different times helped us to take care of each other.

I am very happy to be part of Bethany where I can learn and worship, deepen my knowledge and faith in the Lord and be a part of ONE Bethany.

I would like to finish by sharing two verses that have proved to be very meaningful to me. I hope they speak to you too.

I grew up in a village. My father was a businessman and my mother was a homemaker. My family did not have any religion. When I was young I went to a Christian Secondary School. I was the first batch of students there, and the school took in students from various backgrounds, religions, and also foreigners. Some of the teachers were prejudice in the way they handled manners, showing favouritism to students from rich families and students from families who went to church. Because of this I had a disagreement with my teacher and I left school, learning business from my father since then.

After marriage, because of work partnerships with my friends, I had to travel frequently. My wife would take care of our 3 sons. One year, we moved house and I had to transfer my youngest son to a nearby Catholic school. Our application was rejected even after I saw the principal of the school. When I came out of the principal's office, I met a teacher whom I knew. He revealed to me that money could resolve the problem. 2 days later I met the principal again and asked how I could get my son into the school. He told me the school piano was spoilt and a new one was needed, it cost about \$4,500. It was only when I agreed to his condition that my son was accepted into school. These experiences gave me a bad impression of Christianity for many years.

Many years passed and my sons graduated, got married, and had kids. Their 3 families became Christians. Whenever there were special events, they would invite me to church with them. 3 years ago, an accident changed my life. I fell from about a 3-metre height in my company warehouse. Because it was lunch time, there was no one around to help me. I felt the world spinning, I could see stars, and I was about to faint. During that time, I prayed to God to help me. About 10 mins later, I stabilized a little but was still numb on my left arm and leg and could not stand. Thankfully I could use my right hand to contact my youngest son to help me. I prayed to God again to help me and not let me faint.

Shortly, my son arrived and brought me to Khoo Teck Phuat hospital A&E. An X-ray was taken and it showed that my left wrist bone was broken. My left leg was also

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broken and immediate surgery was needed. I was afraid that I could not stand ever again. Initially there was no bed for me, but Dr Tan from Bethany saw me and arranged for a temporary bed. I managed to go for surgery the next day. Thank God everything went smoothly.

Although I was initially very worried that I could not stand again, the comfort and prayers from my children and grandchildren lightened my pain and encouraged me to go for the surgery. After the surgery, I could not move half my body because my left arm and leg were in a cast. Thankfully my family took turns to visit and pray for me, including the church friends of my 3 children. Each time they left, I would always feel peace and joy in the heart. I stayed in hospital for more than a month because I was transferred to a general hospital. Church friends continued to visit and this made me feel how loving Christians are. That year, during my birthday BBQ celebration, I made a decision and told my whole family that I wanted to go to Church.

After I was discharged and able to walk with crutches, Roger brought me frequently to Bethany. I have experienced warmth and love from the pastors and church members in Bethany. I decided to attend Catechism Class to learn more about the faith and the teachings of the Lord. I also began to attend the weekly SSP sessions to increase my faith and to let go of my unpleasant experiences in the past. I want to thank God for overseeing all that has happened, He has made my hardened heart tender, and allowed me to experience His love mercy. Thus, I hope to be a part of Bethany, and to be able to know Him more and more.

我信主的旅程

我从小是在村里长大,父亲是商人母亲家庭主妇,没有宗教信仰。直到我被派到附近一所新的教会中学,我们是第一批学生,而且所收的学生都来自不同的背景和宗教,还有很多外国学生。有的老师在教学或处理事情上有偏见,如特别地对待有钱人的学生和教会学生。我因此和老师起了冲突而离开学校,从此便跟父亲学做生意。

结婚后我与朋友做生意又常出国做工,三个儿子都由太太照顾。有一年,我们搬了家,因些我们必须为我最小的儿子传校到附近的一间教会学校。 见了校长后,仍然被拒绝。当我走出教室时,我遇见了一位认识的老师,

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他透露说给钱就能解决。两天后我再去见校长问他有什么方法能让我儿子来这里上学。他告诉我学校钢琴坏了要买新的,大概要四千五百元。我答应了他的条件后,他才接受小儿子的报名。因为这些事件,多年来我一直对基督教有着不好的印象。

不知不觉几年过去了,儿子们都上了大学,毕业后也都结婚生子,三个家庭都信基督教。偶尔有特别节目,都邀请我跟他一起去教堂。三年前,一次的意外改变了我。那一天我在公司货台上大概3米高跌倒,因为午餐时间公司没人。那时我感觉地球循转,周围都是星星,好像要晕倒。那时我求神帮我,大概10多分钟才稳定下来,不过左边手脚都麻痹,不能站起来。还好右手可以动拿起手机打电话给小儿子,叫他快回来帮我。我再次求神帮我,希望不要晕过去。

不多久小儿子回来把我送去最近的 Khoo Teck Phuat 医院的急诊室。医院的人马上替我照X光,才得知左边腕骨碎了,需要开刀放螺丝在里面,左手碗也裂了,左脚也裂了,需要马上动手术。我当时很害怕在也不能站起来。原本没床位,不过一位伯大尼的陈医生来见我后,我便被安排了一个临时床位。隔天早上也动手术。感谢主一切都很顺利。

本来很担心以后在也站不起来,不过孩子们和孙子们的安慰和祷告使我减轻痛苦,让我安心去开刀。手术后,左手和脚都包了石膏,半边都不能动。还好家人轮流来拜访祷告。以及三个孩子教会都有教友来拜访和祷告,每次他们离开后我都觉得安心快乐。就这样住院一个多月。然后医院要我转到别的综合医院,可是教友还是继续来探望,使我感到基督督都很有爱心。就这样,在那一年我的生日BBQ会时我就做了决定,并且告诉所有在场的家人,我要去教会。

出院后,当我可拿拐杖走路时,Roger就常带我来伯大尼教会。在这里我觉得牧师和教友都很友善也很有爱心。我就决定来教理课,可理解多一点教理及耶稣的话语,同时也参加每周的乐龄活动,增加信心,放下不愉快的

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过去。我要感谢神一直都在监管着这一切所发生的事件,是神把我僵硬的心给结溶化,让我感受到祂的爱和怜悯。因些我希望能成为伯大尼的一份子,好让我能更深切的认识祂。
