

- ¹⁴I am the good shepherd; and I know My *sheep,* and am known by My own.
- ¹⁵ As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep.
- ¹⁶ And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd.
- ¹⁷ "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.
- ¹⁸ No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

 John 10:14-18

A word of Encouragement

How amazing and wonderful that after 4 long years (our last Family Camp was in March 2019) we can look forward to our Family Camp 2023! We thank God for the privilege to gather as a church family to study God's Word once again.

"To live is Christ and to die is gain" - Philippians 1:21

This year's camp theme is "To live is Christ and to die is gain." Pastor will help us to better understand what the Scriptures teach (the theology) about life and death and how that knowledge must impact the way we live (the testimony) our lives today. Let us come prepared to consider how we are living today and what we are seeking in our lives. Are we seeking the Lord or are we spending most of our time chasing after things of the world?

We pray that you will set aside time for this Family Camp and that your lives will be enriched and encouraged to live for Christ.

Family Camp Costing and Sponsorship

We would like to provide a brief update on the cost of running the Family Camp. The hotel, Le Grandeur has faced significant inflationary pressures (especially for food, labour and materials) in the last two years, and this has resulted in an increase in the hotel room charges. We thank God that we are able to maintain the camp fees for majority of the campers but for some categories, there will be an increase of 15 to 35%. If you face any challenges with the camp fees, do speak with us for sponsorship.

Regarding sponsorship, actually all campers are sponsored for the camp

as there are additional costs (for example, the bus transport and the tea breaks) that are not computed into the camp fees. We are grateful for church ministries and individuals who have supported the Family Camp ministry in the past, either in the form of special equipment or financial support to offset the overall cost of the Family Camp. If you would like to support our Family Camp this year, please direct your gifts to the church and indicate that the gift is in support of the Family Camp.

As we prepare ourselves for the Family Camp, let us find the sense of oneness and togetherness that we can minister to one and all in Bethany for the glory of God's Kingdom. Indeed, let the name of Jesus be praised and honoured by our lives.
